**NOTICE OF RACE**

Chicago Yacht Club shall host the Jimmy Talbot Memorial Regatta September 30 & October 1, 2006. The Chicago Yacht Club is the race organizing authority. The races shall be held in the open waters of Lake Michigan off of Belmont Harbor, Chicago, Illinois.

**1. Rules**

**1.1 General Rules** The races will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2005 – 2008.

**2. Eligibility and Entry**

**2.1 Eligibility** Races are open to all Laser, Laser Radial, V15, Vectors and 420s (see 2.2 for 420 eligibility)

**2.2 420 eligibility and format for 420 High School Class**

**420s** (No traps; no spinnakers)--1 boat needed per team. (See team description below,) This is a Round Robin event. All boats will be furnished by Chicago Yacht Club. The regatta will be sailed in the high school sailing format for **420** divisions. A team shall consist of a skipper and crew for "A" division and a skipper and crew for "B" division, making a minimum of four sailors per team. Unlimited alternates are permitted. ISSA Procedural Rule 4 shall govern substitutions.

**Any sailor who has not yet graduated from the 12<sup>th</sup> grade may compete and who is not below the 9<sup>th</sup> grade.** If any single sailor or any skipper/crew combination wishes to compete but is not a part of a team, that single sailor or skipper/crew combination shall, when possible, be assigned to a team consisting of other such unattached sailors.

**2.3. Entry** Eligible yachts shall be entered by submitting a completed Jimmy Talbot Memorial Regatta Entry Form or online entry form and entry fee to the Regatta Committee prior to September 22, 2006

Entries received after September 22, 2006 shall be charged a US\$15 late fee. All entries shall be received by the Regatta Committee no later than on September 30, 8AM CDT.

**4. Sailing Instructions**

Sailing Instructions shall be available at Registration. Any additional sailing instruction or notice shall be posted on the Official Notice Board at the Chicago Yacht Club Belmont Station. Separate Sailing Instructions will be available for 420 high school course

**5. Racing**

Racing shall take place in the open waters of Lake Michigan near Belmont Harbor. Refer to the Sailing Instructions for detailed description of racing area and courses. It is the race committee's intent to run 10 races, the Race committee may run more if time permits. No race shall start after 1400 hour on Sunday.

**6. Scoring**

The low point scoring system **RRS, Appendix A** shall be used. One drop after 6 races completed in the Laser and V15 fleet.

6.1 for the 420s One race in each division shall constitute a regatta. This modifies ISSA Procedural Rule 7.

6.2 For the Lasers, Vectors and V15 3 races shall constitute a regatta

**7. Awards.** will be presented to crews of boats finishing 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> in each Class with more than 10 entries. The Jimmy Talbot Award will be presented according to its Deed of Gift.

**8. Launching** All boats shall be afloat by 1030 hours and all boats and trailers shall be stored as directed by regatta chairman.

**I-90/94** to Chicago. Exit interstate at **Irving Park Road**, heading east.

Turn right (south) on **Inner Drive/Marine Drive**. Turn left (east) on **Belmont Ave**.

Belmont crosses Lake Shore Drive through an underpass.

Chicago YC is at the south end of Belmont Harbor (see diagram).

*Note that trailers are prohibited on Lake Shore Drive.*
