RULES

The regatta will be governed by the 2005-2008 Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US Sailing, including Appendix D, and the Vanguard 15 Class Association except as modified below or in the sailing instructions. The sailing instructions will be made available at registration and skippers meeting.

RACING

Racing will consist of round-robin rotation(s). Depending on racing conditions and the number of teams present, a final four rotation may be sailed with qualifying teams determined by the results of the full rotation(s) completed.

PROTESTS

A display of a red flag is not needed to file a protest and protests are encouraged.

ELIGIBILITY and TEAMS

A team shall consist of three Vanguard 15s and six crew of an unrestricted mass. Teams will be formed prior to registration. Send email to luhan414@gmail.com if you are planning on sailing.

REGISTRATION

Competitors must register and pay as a team. Individual registrations will not be accepted. The fee will be \$75 per team.

SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

Saturday, October 27:

Registration: 8:30-9:30am

Competitors meeting: 9:30am

First warning: 10:30 am

No race shall start after 5pm

ENTERTAINMENT

There will be a party at CCYC after racing. Dinner is included, cash bar.

REGATTA SITE and RACING AREA

The regatta site will be the Chicago Corinthian Yacht Club, Chicago, IL.

The racing area will be offshore in the vicinity between Belmont and Montrose harbors. Final location will be in the sailing instructions.

SCORING

Shall be according to Appendix D, with the exception that D4.2 is modified as follows: *A tie for first place shall be resolved by*

(a) the number of races won when the tied teams met

(b) a sail-off if possible

(c) the remaining prescriptions in D4.2 in the order they are listed

PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded following the final tabulating of all races. There will be a prize for the team with the best costume. This prize will probably be more desirable than the prize for 1st place.
